Equine Canada Statement of Principal

Equine Canada (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities. Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment. Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in their handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose. Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professional and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operation procedure. Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare. Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions. Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

2006 Jump Canada Levy

Jump Canada is a committee of Equine Canada responsible for all aspects of show jumping in Canada from the grassroots to the international level. The board members are elected by the stakeholders in the sport - riders, owners, and competition organizers.

As a Class 1A to 7 recognized national EC Hunter/Jumper competition all EMG horse shows are required to remit fees of **\$10.00 per horse** entered in the hunter/jumper divisions to Jump Canada in order to support their developmental programs. These funds will be used as follows:

- 60% Hunter, Young Rider and Domestic programs
- 35% National and International Teams
- 5% Administration including publicity & PR

This levy is supported by EC and failure to participate may lead to suspension of membership.

General Rules

Please read carefully

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the EC Rule book, will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show management, whose decision will be final.

The show management further reserves the right to cancel, postpone, change or reschedule any class or condition they deem advisable without notification.

Entries: All entries received after the entry closing date will be assessed a \$25.00 post entry fee without exception. Entries made the day of the competition will pay an additional premium of \$5.00 per class. Phone entries are **not** acceptable, and numbers will not be issued until the entries are completed and signed and an **Open Cheque is left with the office.**

All Entries must have **proper signatures**, complete **addresses**, **EC, OHJA and Passport numbers!** **EC and O.H.J.A** membership numbers for all riders and owners, and **passport numbers** for all horses are **mandatory**. **Current copies of all memberships must accompany entries and passports must be submitted to the horse show office.** Entries competing without these numbers will not receive any provincial points and will be required to pay temporary membership fees and may receive warning letters from EC and/or be fined.

It is the **responsibility of the exhibitor** to provide to the horse show office valid proof of all memberships prior to competing. Any one competing without valid proof of 2006 EC membership and / or EC passport will pay the temporary membership / passport fee at each competition until it is provided. **These fees are non refundable upon the completion of the respective competition.**

Changes: The office closes 1 hour after the last class of the day for any adds or declarations. Any changes processed after this will be considered post or late entries. Post entries will go first and will pay a premium of \$5.00 per class.

Day Of Adds / Entries: Day of entries and adds will only be accepted if the schedule permits and will be treated as a late post entry and will pay a premium of \$5.00 per class plus the \$25.00 post entry fee and will go first in all classes of that day.

Prize Money: Prize money will be credited to each horse's account. Prize cheques made payable to the **owner** of the entry will be mailed within 21 days of the close of the horse show. Complete addresses must be given to the horse show office in order for any cheque to be mailed. Cheques will only be issued to those entries whose accounts have been paid in full.

Returned Cheques: A **\$50.00** charge will be assessed on all returned cheques and the exhibitor will not be allowed to show at any future EMG Shows until the account has been settled. Unsettled accounts will be turned over to the EC for collection.

Numbers: Riders wearing the incorrect number or no number may be charged an additional office fee of **\$25.00**.

Schedule: Management may move the start time of any class forward by 30 minutes without notice to exhibitors. Management may also move rings or reschedule classes as required. Every effort will be made to provide as much notification as possible.

Dress Code: See Rule G107 Polo Shirts are acceptable attire in the jumper rings during the week unless otherwise noted. Proper Attire (Jackets, ties, chokers, etc.) is required for all Jumpers beginning Saturday morning and for the balance of each show.

Scratches: If **Hunter** entries are cancelled in writing, prior to noon one day before the show, all entry fees will be refunded less a **Scratch fee and the administration fee** (plus GST). After that there will be no refunds during the show unless the horse show veterinarian issues a certificate. Please Note: Entries which may be processed without payment, and then scratched will be charged a **scratch fee and administration fee** (plus GST) and will be considered an outstanding account until paid.

Non-Showing Horses: will be charged a fee of **\$50.00**

General Rules (Continued)

Please read carefully

Jumper Nomination Fee: \$110.00

Nomination Fees are required for all jumpers at all shows with the exception of the 1m & 1.10m Schooling, and Junior Amateur 1m. There is no exception to this rule. Nomination fees will be refunded less a **\$25.00** processing fee if the following conditions are met: **1)** the horse has not shown in any classes. **2)** the horse show veterinarian must issue a certificate.

All jumper classes will be conducted under Articles 238.2.2 unless otherwise specified. Riders are reminded that they must declare each day for the next day's classes. You may choose to remain in one division and declare on the entry form at the time of entering or at the office prior to the show for all of your classes. Riders must declare the day before the show their first day's classes. Declarations must be in the horse show office within 1 hour of the last class or will be processed as a late/post entry.

**No Same Day Scratches without Vet Certificate.
Telephone Declarations are Not Acceptable.**

STALLS:

Spring Circuit Stall **\$125.00 each week** for 4 Weeks if ordered by April 24, 2006.

2 Week Stall **\$135.00 per week**,

1 Week Stall **\$145.00 per week**.

If available Late Stalls **\$165.00**, Day Stalls **\$40.00**.

Due to the high demand for stalls, please order early to ensure availability.

Stalls must be booked in writing on the Stall request form found in this prize list. You are responsible for payment of all stalls ordered. Stalls are available after am 1 day prior to the start of the horse show and all horses must be removed by 12 noon the day following the completion of each show. Horses remaining in stalls after this will be charged for the second week stall.

STALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.

Camper Fees: Camper spaces **\$125.00** per show.

There is absolutely no grey water drainage allowed on the grounds. Any exhibitor not abiding by this Town of Caledon by-law will be fined and removed from the property. Daily pump-out is available. Please inquire at the show office.

Vehicles: all vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. There is no parking on the roads or in the barn areas at any time. All motorized vehicles including golf carts, scooters, dirt bike, 4-wheelers, etc may be operated by **Licensed Drivers Only**.

Wash Racks: Horses must be bathed in wash rack areas only, no bathing in barn aisles. The wash rack area is for bathing horses only.

Notice to American Exhibitors: While every effort will be made to assist you in the variances of EC rules over AHSA rules the sole responsibility is entirely the Exhibitors to be aware of EC rules. EMG does not accept cheques marked payable in Canadian Funds drawn on a US account.

Dog Rule: Any loose dog on the property will be fined \$100.00 on the first infraction. If found loose a second time owner will be required to remove the animal from the property. **As in any public park owners are required to abide by the Town of Caledon "Poop & Scoop" by-law.**

The Caledon Equestrian Park Pavilion is a licensed area. No alcoholic beverages are allowed inside the pavilion other than those purchased at the bar located inside the pavilion.

Veterinarian/Farrier Services:

Responsibility of payment for services and supplies: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any bills for veterinary, farrier and food services. Any exhibitor not meeting this obligation to the official Show Veterinarian or farrier may be deemed an undesirable exhibitor and entries from that exhibitor may not be accepted at subsequent shows.

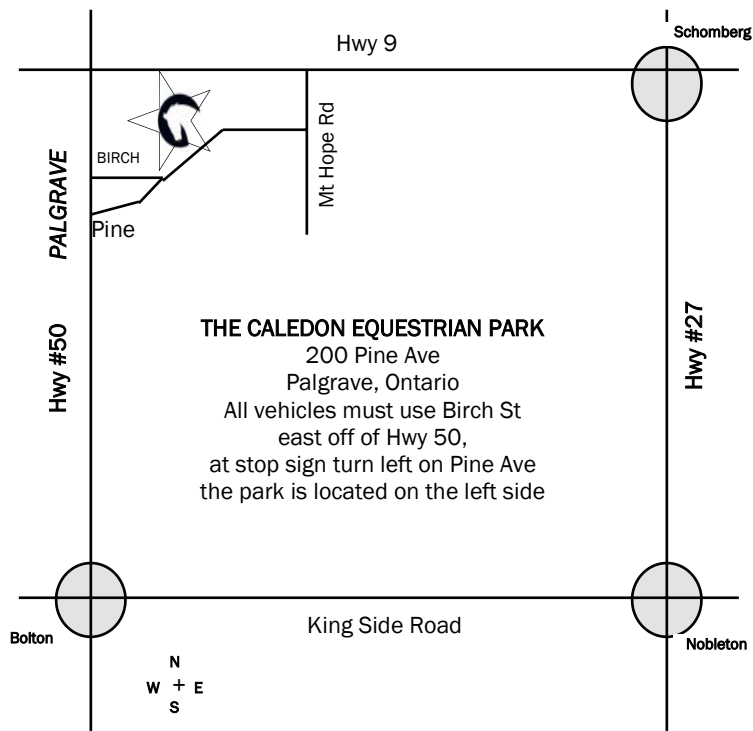

Welcome to 2006

We hope that all of you have enjoyed the off season. Our Thanks to each of you for making 2005 such an enjoyable success and we sincerely hope that you will enjoy some of the new offerings we have this year. We are very fortunate to have attracted many new sponsors for 2006. We trust that you will try to make use of the various services and products they offer. We can not thank them enough for their generous support.

Our circuit stall program was very successful last year and we will continue it in 2006. We will make every effort to accommodate preferred stall locations on a first come first serve basis. Our policy is:

Circuit Stalls are available for all 4 spring shows at discount prices. You will maintain the same stalls for the entire circuit of 4 shows. While you are away your stalls will be locked and not rented out to events that take place at the Park. These stalls will be located closet to the rings. Don't forget that half stalls are not permitted.

We thank you for abiding by our motorized vehicle rules. We all aware of the convenience that golf carts and motor bikes offer, however we all are also aware of the danger. The licensed driver rule will be enforced without exception.

To eliminate confusion and constant questions about height of the jumps, the height is in metric and makes up part of the name of the class. An example 1m Jumper or Junior/Am 1.20m. This brings our naming conventions in line with world wide standards and was very helpful last year.

You will notice also that we have opened up the Pleasure Hunter division for riders that do not qualify for the amateur divisions but are looking for a place to compete. Those riders that have not competed in the open divisions at the show, but also don't qualify as amateurs now will have a division. This is a pilot project at the request of some of our coaches and teachers and hope they will support it. As usual there is no perfect solution to this ongoing problem, but we hope that this at least addresses the issue and is a starting point.

Our long term goals include to increase the number of hunter rings that we have available, particularly on the weekends. Once we accomplish this and should this new opportunity be successful we will have the option of providing more classes etc.

Our real estate development project is nearing fruition. You will notice that a viewing park is now located on Mount Hope Road on the east side of the property. Here you can find information on the development. We look forward to discussing any questions that you have on this very exciting undertaking.

As always we have many plans to continue to improve the park. Our focus is and will remain the comfort of both our exhibitors and their horses. Please feel free to contact me or any of our staff if we can be of any help.

We thank you again for your terrific support in 2005 and we look forward to seeing all of you in May.

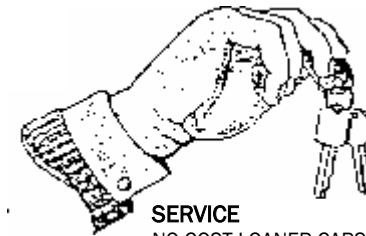
